Name change for the Vontobel Fund - TwentyFour Sustainable Strategic Income fund

I am writing to you because you are invested in the Vontobel Fund - TwentyFour Sustainable Strategic Income fund, provided by Vontobel Asset Management S.A.

Vontobel will change the name of the fund from **28 July 2026**.

You'll see the new fund name on our valuations and statements after this date.

The fund objective, risk profile and Ongoing Charges Figure (OCF) / Total Expense Ratio (TER) will not change.

The OCF/TER represents the ongoing charges for the fund, expressed as a percentage. It is the sum of the Annual Management Charge (AMC) and all other running costs of the fund. OCF is increasingly replacing TER.

Why the change is happening

Vontobel has confirmed that the minimum proportion of the fund's net assets invested in sustainable investments will reduce from 50% to 15%, so they will be updating the investment policy to reflect this change.
