Personal Data Retention: supplementary to privacy notices

Quilter group entities will retain personal data only for as long as there exists a reasonable business requirement or longer only where there is a legal or regulatory obligation to do so. We have set out below our current retention periods together with examples of how they apply. These periods will be reviewed from time to time.

Data when in active use is not subject to a retention period limit. Active use means, for example, while you are still a customer of a Quilter business or a user of a Quilter product or service.

Each retention period is therefore the period of time that the data will be retained after the last active use. At the end of the retention period the data will be destroyed, deleted or anonymised (this means that the data can never be linked or traced to any individual) depending on the storage media and the technology available at that time.

Prospective Client Data	Enquiry notes; application forms.	• 1 year
Adviser Personal Data	Name and contact details of your financial adviser.	• 7 years
Marketing Opt Out Information	Records of when you have declined to receive marketing content to ensure that we do not contact you inappropriately	Indefinitely Please note if you have requested that your information be erased. Quilter will not keep a record that you declined marketing and so you risk future contact, should your details appear in marketing lists.
